### Meeting Minutes

Council Member Mitchell made a motion to approve the January 8, 2024 regular meeting minutes, seconded by Council Member Joe Soeder. Council Member Whitehouse abstained from voting. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Warford made a motion to approve the January 10, 2024 special meeting minutes, seconded by Council Member Mitchell. Council Member Whitehouse abstained from voting. Motion carried 5-0.

### Financial Report January 2024

Council Member Warford made a motion to approve the January 2024 financial report. Council Member Mitchell seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

The 2022-2023 audit was distributed to the council to review for the next meeting.

### Police Department – January 2024

Chief Kaiser presented the monthly police report and answered all questions.

The case involving the two dogs that attacked the pony was discussed. The SWAT raid on February 9<sup>th</sup> was also discussed. Nineteen weapons, ammunition, and drugs were found.

Officer West inquired as to whether Fischer Homes is including ordinances in their packets. They are supposed to.

Mayor Williams stated that a monthly newsletter will start going out to the residents.

Chief Kaiser spoke about the Reach alert program which would allow the City of Heritage Creek to send messages in real time to the residents. The cost is \$2.50 per household, and the first year would be discounted at \$1.25 per household.

There was a complaint about residents parking in front of stop signs waiting for their children riding the bus.

Council Member Angie Soeder wanted to ensure that the newsletter is going to be sent out.


## Mayor Comments
