AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO THE ASSESSMENT OF REAL ESTATE AND THE LEVYING OF AN AD VALOREM TAX FOR PURPOSE OF PROVIDING NECESSARY CITY SERVICES FOR THE BENEFIT AND GENERAL WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY. THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERITAGE CREEK, JEFFERSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 181 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and section 132.285 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, the City Council hereby declares to elect to use the Jefferson County Tax Assessments, as determined by the Jefferson County Property Administrator, of property situated within the City as the basis for ad valorem tax levies for the year 2022.

SECTION 2. The City is to remit to the office of the Jefferson County Valuation Administrator such compensation or changes as may be required by section 132.285 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

SECTION 3. The ad valorem tax rate on property is hereby fixed at .192 per one hundred dollars, (\$100.00) property assessment valuation.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to this Ordinance, the payment of taxes shall be due and payable on or before December 31, in the taxable year. Taxes not paid by the second day of January of the year following the taxable year, shall be delinquent status, subject to penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount of taxes and payable, including interest charges of one percent (1%) per month until paid.

For what necessary cost, including legal services, the City may be obligated to assume for the collection or prosecution of a claim in a Court of Law for delinquent taxes, penalties and interest, including enforcement of a lien, under the laws of Kentucky and of this Ordinance shall be found chargeable as an assessment and recovered against the subject property owner or property or both, the property owner and property.


SECTION 5. The proceeds from property taxes paid shall be credited to the General Fund Accounts of the City from which expenditures may be made there from upon authorization by the City Council for the administration and services rendered for the benefit, public works, public safety and general welfare of the Community, in connection with the operation of the City Government.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its passage and publication.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR THE COLLECTION, PICK UP AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, TRASH, AND WASTE MATTER, IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE COMMUNITY AND TO COVER ALL EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THIS PURPOSE.

Whereas garbage, trash and waste matter collection, pick-up and disposal is now provided on a contractual basis between the city and a private contractor; established by an Ordinance adopted July 12, 1976 under a "Garbage and Waste Collection Assessment" which has proved satisfactory to the community, necessitates obligation assuring continued said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Heritage Creek, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 2022 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 the garbage and waste collection assessment is hereby set at \$ 14.62 per month, for a total of \$175.44, per fiscal year, (yard waste included per month) for each single family residence; and \$14.01 per month for a total of \$168.12 per fiscal year, (yard waste included per month) for each Homestead Residence.

The Foregoing assessment shall be made a part of the property tax bill of the City of Heritage Creek for the fiscal year of July 1, 2022 to and including June 30, 2023 and shall be due and payable at the same time and place as real estate taxes.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its passage and publication.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed such budget proposal and the necessary modifications,




SECTION 1. That the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 is here by adopted as follows:
